ITINERARY

[Note: Bathroom/Porta-potty facilities available at Audubon Center, and at Stops 2 and 4.]

1:25 PM	Meet at Dungeness River Audubon Center GRAVEL Parking Lot <i>If you can carpool, please meet at River Center parking lot (the one just past the Audubon sign on the right) early enough for a 1:30 PM departure.</i>
1:30 PM	Travel to Site #1: From River Center, turn right onto Priest Rd, right onto W. Washington, left at round-about and onto River Rd. Follow River Rd south to Otter Way. Park along Otter Way, which is 2.5 miles from Hwy 101.
1:45 PM	SITE #1: Serenity Lane Riparian Restoration Project Robert Knapp, Jamestown S’Klallam Tribe
2:15 PM	Travel to Site #2: Head back to River Rd, right onto Hwy 101, take Sequim Ave Exit, straight to Sequim-Dungeness Way, right to stay on Sequim-Dungeness Way. As you approach site, you will see orange “work ahead” signs on right. Park on shoulder in this area. [Porta-potty available onsite].
2:40 PM	SITE #2: 3 Crabs Nearshore & Estuarine Restoration Project Kevin Long, North Olympic Salmon Coalition
3:40 PM	Travel to Site #3: Head back out on Sequim-Dungeness Way, right onto East Anderson, left onto Towne Rd. Park at the Old Schoolhouse.
3:50 PM	SITE #3: Lower Dungeness Floodplain Restoration & Dike Setback Project Cathy Lear, Clallam County
4:15 PM	Travel to Site #4: Head south on Towne Rd, right onto Woodcock Rd, first right onto Fasola Rd. Park next to building or along the driveway.
4:20 PM	SITE #4: Hurd Creek Fish Hatchery Tour & Hurd Creek Bank Stabilization Project Jeff Gufler and Scott Williams Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife
5:00 PM	Adjourn and Travel Back to Dungeness River Audubon Center: Head back out on Fasola Rd, left on Woodcock Rd, right onto Towne Rd, left onto Old Olympic Hwy, right onto N. Kendall Rd, right onto Hendrickson Rd.
